OVERVIEW

The discipline specific regulations, as set out in regulations section 19 (2) of the Health Professions Act, require the applicant to provide, as part of the application process, proof of successful completion of a program of study for the specific discipline.

POLICY

To be considered a graduate of an Approved Program of Study, an applicant must have graduated from a program currently accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Canadian University Programs (CACUP) in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology.

Graduates from an education program in Audiology/Speech-Language Pathology that is not accredited by CACUP will be directed by NLCHP to follow the application process for internationally-educated applicants.

PROCEDURE

The College will inform the Newfoundland and Labrador Council of Health Professionals (NLCHP) Registration Committee of the Approved Programs of Study.
