The discipline specific regulations as set out in regulations section 19 (2) of the Health Professions Act require the applicant to provide, as part of the application process, proof of successful completion of a program of study for the specific discipline.

Policy:

To be considered a graduate of an Approved Program of Study, an applicant must have graduated from a program currently accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Canadian University Programs in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology.

Procedure:

- The College will inform the Newfoundland and Labrador Council of Health Professionals (NLCHP) Registration Committee of the Approved Programs of Study.
